



**Honors Thesis:**

Submit thesis the week before finals the semester of graduation. All qualifying submissions should be

- 1) Directly related to student's major
- 2) Completed during student's senior year
- 3) Properly researched and cited using the preferred citation method for the student's academic discipline
- 4) A reflection of the "best" work the student has completed during his or her studies
- 5) Approximately 10-15 pages in length depending on the subject matter,
- 6) Produced under the supervision of a faculty mentor.

*Note: Assignments completed for course credit may not be used as student's Honors Thesis. The thesis should be based on course work, but should go beyond course work and represent an independent project that the student has undertaken. Significant work achieved through group projects or undergraduate research projects may be considered.*
