- **TEXTBOOK:** Macroeconomics, by W. McEachern, 6th ed. (Online book only). Chapters: 1 - 9, 11 – 15.
- **IMPORTANT:** BUY THE ONLINE TEXTBOOK. ONLY THE BOOK. ONLY THEN CAN YOU FOLLOW THE READING LIST AND DO THE CHAPTER PRACTICE QUESTIONS. I DO NOT MAKE ONE CENT OUT OF THIS. I AM SAYING THIS BECAUSE IT IS ESSENTIAL TO HAVE THE BOOK.

- The entire course outline, syllabus, reading list, power points, practice questions etc. are all spelled out.
- I expect you to read the chapter topics, and take the exams.
- None of my exams. are comprehensive.
- You will take 5 online exams. during the session and one online final exam. on the dates and times mentioned below.
- **Exam. 1 is June 3th.** It is a 40 minute exam. It is open from 8 am - 12 pm (afternoon) on that day. It will be open for 4 hours. It will be 20 multiple choice questions (MCQ's), worth 1 point each. Once you start, the exam. will be open for the next 40 minutes. You have to finish it in one session. It will be Chapters 1 and 2 only. Be prepared with these 2 chapters. Cannot do it? Drop my class. There is no other choice.
- **Exam. 2 is June 8th.** A 40 minute exam., open from 8 am - 12 pm on that day. It will be Chapters 3 and 4 only. Rest of the rules are same as previous exams.
- **Exam. 3 is June 11th.** A 40 minute exam., open from 8 am - 12 pm on that day. It will be Chapters 5 and 6 only. Rest of the rules are same as previous exams.

- **Exam. 4 is June 16th.** A 40 minute exam., open from 8 am - 12 pm on that day. It will be Chapters 7 and 8 only. Rest of the rules are same as previous exams.
- **Exam. 5 is June 19th.** A 40 minute exam., open from 8 am - 12 pm on that day. It will be Chapters 9 and 11 only. Rest of the rules are same as previous exams.
- **Final Exam.: is open from June 25th (8am through 8pm).** It will be open for 12 hours. It will be 50 multiple choice questions (MCQ's), worth 1 point each. It is a 2 hour exam. Once you start, the exam. will be open for the next 120 minutes. You have to finish it in one session. It will be Chapters 12, 13, 14, and 15.
- **There are no essay exams, no assignments, no home works, no projects, no case studies. Nothing.**
- You will be graded out of a total of 150 points (20+20+20+20+20+50).
- Grading scale is given below.
- During this 4 week session, I am online most of the time. You can email me anytime (absolutely anytime) and I will try to answer you ASAP.
- My discussion board will be open all the time, 24 hours a day, the whole session.
- You can post your questions, and I or anyone from class can (and will) answer them.
- This will be open to the whole class.
